## Palette - Deco Art Americana Acrylics:

Winter Blue  
Uniform Blue  
Warm White  
French Mauve  
Raspberry  
Cranberry Wine  
Reindeer Moss Green  
Avocado  
Raw Sienna

DA Wood Sealer  
DA Varnish  
OPT: Sparkle Medium of your choice

## Instructions:

Step 1: Seal the wood piece with wood sealer. Let dry. Sand lightly. Basecoat as follows:

**Rose:** French Mauve; **Leaves:** Reindeer Moss Green; **Letters M:** Winter Blue

## Shading & Detail:

### Rose:

Step 1: Using the 8 flat side-loaded in a brush mix of Raspberry + Cranberry Wine, float the shading on the petals (use the photo as a guide). Deepen in random areas with a side-load of just Cranberry Wine. (Again use the photo as a guide).

Step 2: Using the 8 flat, highlight the petals with a brush mix of French Mauve + Warm White. Further brighten with just a side-load of Warm White.

Step 3 (optional): Using the 10 flat side-loaded in Raw Sienna, float a soft tint down the left side of the rose.

### Leaves:

Step 1: Using the 8 flat and a side-load of Avocado, float the shading on the petals and on the underside of the center vein line.

Step 2: Using the 8 flat and a side-load brush mix of Reindeer Moss Green + Warm White float the highlight on the petals, (use the photo as a guide). The brightest highlight is floated with just Warm White.

Step 3: Using the 8 flat and a side-load brush mix of Raspberry + Cranberry Wine, float random tints on the petals.

### Letters M:

Step 1: Using the 10 flat, float the initial shading with a brush mix of Winter Blue + Uniform Blue.

Step 2: Line the stripes using the 10/0 liner and Warm White.

Step 3: Using the 10 flat, re-shade the letters with Uniform Blue. Add stylus dots of Warm White down every other stripe.

Step 4: Using the 10 flat and a side-load brush mix of Raspberry + Cranberry Wine, float a soft tint down the outside edges of the letters.

## Finishing:

Varnish following manufacturer's instructions; add sparkle medium over the rose and letters if desired.
