



### Prep Instructions...

Seal if desired, sand lightly. (I recommend DA Multi-Purpose Sealer). I like to base the smaller elements with the 6 filbert or the 3 round; the larger with a 1/2 Oval Glaze or a larger filbert.

#### **HARVEST Coasters**:

Base the coaster shapes completely using Bleached Sand. \*Use the cosmetic sponge to tap the color over the delicate laser cutwork. Let dry and sand lightly; apply the pumpkin as desired, using dark graphite.

**Laser Cut Borders:** Use the cosmetic sponge to tap the metallic colors over the laser-cut out border:

~BLESSED: Bright Copper ~THANKFUL: Festive Green ~GRATEFUL: Rich Espresso

~FAMILY: Berry

**All Pumpkins**: Apply a wash of Golden Straw over all the pumpkins (any similar yellow will

All Stems: Hauser Medium Green (3 round). ~Apply pattern, or sketch, the spine lines.

#### **HALLOWEEN Coasters:**

**Base** the coaster shapes using Lamp Black. \**Use the cosmetic sponge to tap the color over the delicate laser cutwork*. Let dry and sand lightly; apply the pumpkin as desired, using light graphite.

Laser Cut Borders: Use the cosmetic sponge to tap the Craft Twinkles (clear) over the black on the laser-cut border.

**All Pumpkins**: Base in Persimmon; tip in Bright Orange to streak through, (stroke following the pumpkin shape).

**All Stems**: Stroke with Honey Brown, while wet, tip in Golden Straw to brighten (3 round) ~ *Apply pattern, or sketch, the spine lines*.

Shading & Detail...

Please read through the following instructions prior to painting. I like to use the 1/2 Square Wash for most of my floating, moving to the larger 3/4 Square Wash when floating larger areas Use a mop to soften your floated areas, as desired.

## Harvest-Themed Coasters

- 1.) <u>Background</u>: Using the Decorative Mesh (*aka drywall adhesive mesh*) and the **8 ODB** loaded in a coordinating border color, scrub to give it a bit of a texture effect: **Blessed**: Persimmon; **Grateful**: Persimmon or Bright Orange; **Family**: Plum; **Thankful**: Plantation Pine.
- 2.) Scrub using the 10 ODB and Snow White in the "open" areas of the background.
- **3.)** <u>Float</u> Burnt Umber in the corners and under the pumpkins, tap the color downward for a little more "ground" area. Dirty brush into a touch of Persimmon to add a touch of orange tones around the pumpkins and on to the ground.
- **4.)** <u>All Pumpkins</u>: Float a side-load of Persimmon on the pumpkins. Float the indentation (spines) with the same color, deepen the upper and lower area of the pumpkin with Burnt Sienna.
- **5.)** Float a tint of Hauser Medium Green in a few random areas of the pumpkin. Float a tint of Watermelon Slice randomly on the pumpkins; float a tint of Plum in a few areas as you like.
- **6.)** All Stems & Leaves: Float the stems using the 8 flat and a side-load of Plantation Pine; highlight Olive Green. Pull the curly Q's with Burnt Umber. Float around the stem area with a side-load of Plantation Pine. The leaves are stroked using the 6 or 8 flat and Plantation Pine. Line leaves with Lamp Black.
- 7.) <u>Highlight</u>: Through the open area (under where the words will be) with a drybrush scrub of Snow White, **8 ODB**.
- 8.) Linework: Use the 18/0 liner and thin Burnt Umber to line the spines.
- 9. WORDS: Line with Lamp Black; use the 5/0 liner.
- **10.)** <u>Detail</u>: Use the metallic color from each border, to float color over the corners and border of the square; moving the brush (walking) inward, toward the center. Float Lamp Black to deepen the intensity at the corner. Add stylus dots of Olive Green or Bright Orange on the corners.

## Halloween-Themed Coasters:

- ~ Background: Check the borders using thinned Persimmon and the 6 flat. Dot between the checks with Olive Green using the stylus or 18/0 liner.
- ~ All Pumpkins:
- 1.) <u>Shade</u>: The pumpkins are shaded with Persimmon, deepen with Burnt Sienna and then final with Lamp Black. Float the indentations (spines) with Burnt Sienna (back-to-back float).
- **2.)** <u>Highlight & Drybrush</u>: Drybrush through the central areas with Bright Orange and the **6 ODB**; further brighten with a dirty brush into Golden Straw, and then Snow White. Tip the dirty brush into Olive Green and scrub underneath the pumpkins (*walk the scrub downward to fill in*). Drybrush in the cheek area of the pumpkins, using the **8 ODB** and Watermelon Slice.
- 3.) <u>Tint</u>: Float Watermelon Slice randomly to perk up the orange tones. Float Olive Green, using the **8 flat**, to tint and add a bit of interest on the tops of the spines and on the lower left side, as a backlight.
- **4.)** All Stems & Leaves: Float the stems using the 8 flat and a side-load of Burnt Umber. Pull the curly Q's with Honey Brown, tip in a touch of Golden Straw or Snow White to highlight. The leaves are stroked on (6 or 8 flat, or the 6 filbert) and Olive Green, occasionally tip one edge into Bleached Sand or Snow White and overstroke, to brighten. Line leaves with Lamp Black.

- **5.)** Linework: Use the **18/0 liner** and thin Burnt Umber to line the spines (*they could alternately be lined with Lamp Black*). Fill in the eyes and noses with Lamp Black; add a tiny highlight in the eye with Snow White or Bleached Sand.
- **6.)** WORDS: Line with Lamp Black; use the 5/0 liner. \*Option: You can simply put the smiles on the pumpkins, instead of the wording! The swirls are lined with Snow White; when dry, use the 6 ODB and Snow White and softly scrub over these, just to give them a little softness.

## Finishing Details...

- \*Metallics: You can tap the metallic colors from the Harvest coasters over the edges of the Halloween coasters (*I did not, but that is up to you*).
- \*Glamour Dust Glitter Paint: I floated Tiger Orange over the pumpkins; Limelight over the leaves.
- \*Craft Twinkles: I tapped this over the intricate border of the Halloween coasters, it really richens the black!
- \*Galaxy Glitter: You can tap (with a small round) the Solar Flare Orange in a couple areas of the pumpkins (just a bit, to add interest); likewise, the Extraterrestrial Green in a couple areas of the leaves, stems. The Red Nebula looks nice accenting the orange tones. Any of the colors look nice tapped in random areas of the intricate borders! Make yourself happy!

\*Varnish: Erase any remaining graphite and varnish as desired. \*If you are going to use these for hot drinks, make sure you use a protective varnish that will handle it!

Don't forget to paint the back; and maybe add that you painted it on ZOOM during the pandemic of 2020... <eek, sorry!>
